

Giving Back to the Community

Twin Cities Hospitals are stewards of patients' health and are dedicated to delivering high quality and safe care. We are proud to support the larger Twin Cities public health needs by providing exceptional care and making significant contributions to the general health and welfare of our communities. Some recent examples:

Children's Minnesota

Provided nearly \$120 million in Community Benefit in 2016 and more than \$130 million in 2017, including:

- \$4.7 million in health care professional education in both 2016 and 2017
- \$1 million in medical research in 2016 and \$1.4 million in 2017
- \$11 million in community health improvement services in 2016 and \$10.5 million in 2017
- \$82 million in unreimbursed medical costs to Medicaid patients in 2016 and \$95.6 million in 2017
- \$0.9 million in charitable patient care in 2016 and \$1 million in 2017

Fairview Health Services

Provided \$365.49 million in Community Benefit in 2017, including:

- \$100.29 million in workforce development and education
- \$24.67 million in charity care
- \$142.15 million in unreimbursed medical costs to Medicaid patients
- \$5.46 million for medical research

HealthEast

Provided \$80.32 million in Community Benefit in 2017, including:

- \$4.94 million in charity care
- \$55.61 million in unreimbursed medical costs to Medicaid patients

North Memorial Health Care

Provided \$61 million in Community Benefit, including:

- \$13 million in charity care
- \$29 million in unreimbursed medical costs to Medicaid patients
- \$3.9 million in education for health professionals
- \$4.9 million in community health improvement services

Park Nicollet Methodist Hospital

Provided more than \$174 million in Community Benefit, including:

- \$15 million in charity care
- \$156 million in unreimbursed medical costs to Medicaid and Medicare patients
- In 2018, Park Nicollet Foundation raised \$5 million in gifts and commitments and our volunteers contributed 105,674 hours of services valued at \$2.6 million. The Foundation granted \$3.2 million to support our community, research and innovation, and patient and family experience.
